LENT 3 VICAR'S NOTE

Dear people of God,

I write this note in high spirits and full of gratitude. All this is due to training I have been to which was about Leading Your Church Into Growth simply known as **LyCIG**. This ran for three days (Tuesday – Thursday) at Cathedral Room – Cardinal Knox Centre in East Melbourne. The Diocese of Melbourne has organized this Conference and brought the two facilitators; Revds. Sue Cooke and Peters Leech who came all the way from the UK to journey with us for these three days.

One can only emphasize how brilliant and inspiring the training was as it provided tools necessary for Church growth and when we talk about growth, often we think about the numbers only. Well, this **LyCIG** course provides insight as to how the Church should also grow. Growth is natural and it is inevitable. The example given can be that of our Church that has been in existence for more than 180 years since the foundation stone was laid. In the last 180 years, this Parish has gone through some many faces as it embraced change that was necessary has seen it going and being self-sustained.

In LyCIG, they talk about growth that is both *Numerical*, *Missional* and *Spiritual*. The training also highlights the 4Ps as a model to be used to facilitate the growth that we all need. This model was used by St Paul especially while in Athens

(Acts 17). The 4Ps are Prayer, Presence, Proclamation and Persuasion. For us to understand how we go forward with the process, we need to find out what type of congregation we are. There are at least two types namely The Maintenance Church or The Mission Church. All these will be unpacked as we move forward especially after Easter, as we got to carefully journey through the Season of Lent already in full swing.

As we embark on this journey of collectively Leading our Parish into Growth, I am going to need some people who are passionate about Church Growth. I will approach parishioners who will be trained and help us take this project forward. Where will our Parish be in the next fifty years and what will it look like in terms of numbers including young people, spiritually and in its mission to make disciples for Jesus? I am therefore calling you all to please join me in praying the following prayer daily as we intentionally ask God to enhance the growth God has in store for Christ Church – Geelong. The following Prayer has been written specifically for growth:

God of Mission,
who alone brings growth to your Church,
send your Holy Spirit to give
vision to our planning,
wisdom to our actions,
joy to our worship
and power to our witness.
Help our church to grow in numbers,
in spiritual commitment to you,
and in service to our local community,
through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen

May Christ inspire each and everyone of us to play part as we venture into this face in the life of our Parish collectively towards the direction of where God wants us to be at this time of our existence. I am yours, humble in the service of Christ.
