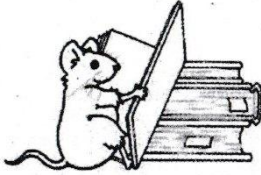

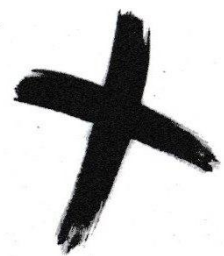

SHROVE TUESDAY: The word shrove is a form of the English word shrive, which means to give absolution for someone's sins by way of Confession and doing penance. Thus Shrove Tuesday was named after the custom of Christians to be "shriven" before the start of Lent. You are invited to a Shrove Tuesday evening with the Vicar to share some lovely pancakes at 7pm in the Church before we begin our Lenten fast.



ASH WEDNESDAY SERVICES: The manner in which time flies is unbelievable. Not so long ago we were looking at the calendars and thinking Lent is late this year and before we realized it was here and almost catching us unawares. Ash Wednesday Services will be as follows: There will be two Services in the morning with the first one starting at 7am without Eucharist. This is meant for those who are rushing either to work or some place in the morning and may not be in a position to attend the evening one. The second

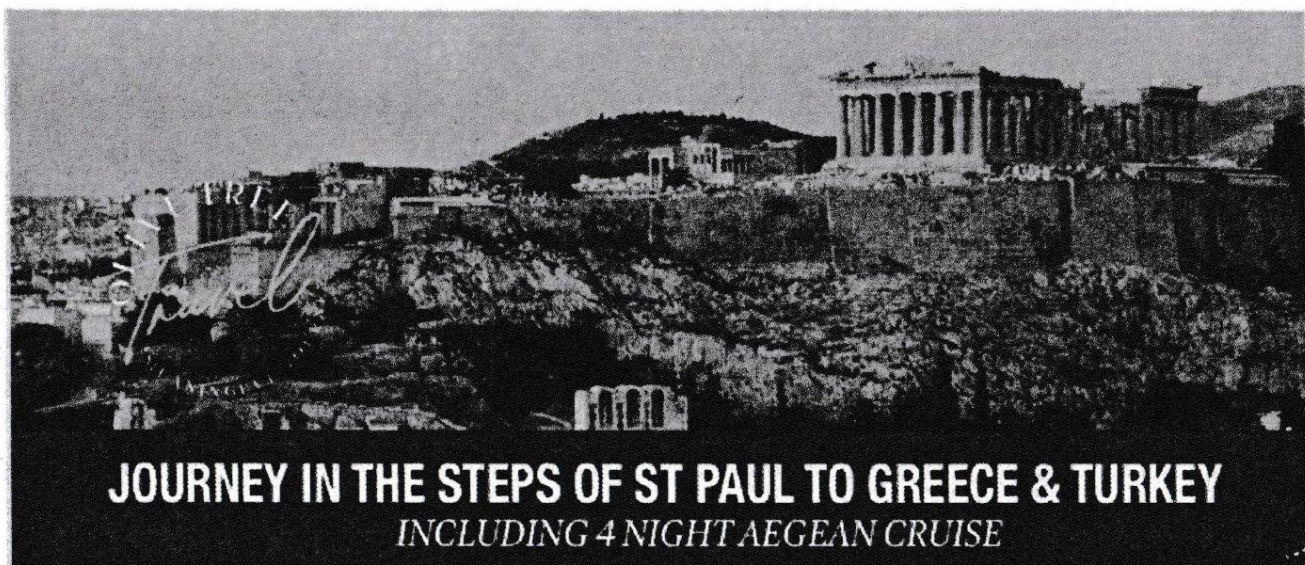


one starts at 10am and the last Ash Wednesday service will start at 7pm. Please get your ashes on Wednesday and start your Lent on a right note.

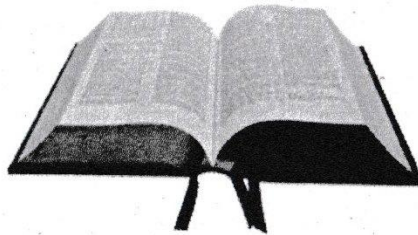
